## 2050: Bring Youth Together for Science & Technology

**2050** is a non-profit event launched by volunteers and Hangzhou Yunqi Science and Technology Innovation Foundation. It is hosted in Yunqi Cloud Town, Hangzhou, China every year in May. It aims to bring the world's youth together for science and technology.

The inaugural **2050** will be held on May 25-27, 2018, with an expected participation from 20,000 young attendees, including 5,000 from overseas. At **2050**, young people around the world can reunite with old friends, make new ones and unleash the power of the young generation to change the world.

**2050** is for the youth and by the youth. At **2050**, there will be no bystanders. Every participant is an owner and shaper of the conference.

**2050** will support more than 100 reunions of youth groups, offer over 100 Next Gen Forums organized by our volunteer producers from diverse backgrounds, and present 100 eye-catching booths in the "Explorer Space" by the most creative young people.

**2050** will also feature music festivals, morning run, science documentary theater, the Yunqi Light Show, and many other exciting programs. **2050** will set up a dedicated camping area and provide 800 tents to those interested in sleeping outside.

Through **2050 Migration Program**, Hangzhou Yunqi Science and Technology Innovation Foundation will fund 100 young people around the world to attend the conference. Exceptional forum speakers and booth presenters can win ten **2050 Youth Awards** with a prize of US\$10,000 each.

For sustainability and environmental consciousness, the **2050** project team promises to minimize the temporary set-up and produce as little waste as possible.

**2050** will provide language support in Chinese, English, French, German, Spanish, Japanese, Korean and Arabic. Beyond these languages, groups of 30 attendees and above can submit a request in advance for language support to the event team.

- ◆ Please remind your attendees to complete registration of 2050 Welcoming Party before May. 7<sup>th</sup>. The final invitation list will be confirmed by the organizing committee.
- ◆ Please complete registration of 2050 Youth Awards Gala before May 7<sup>th</sup>. The gala is only open to conveners. The final invitation list will be confirmed by the organizing committee.
- ◆ Venues will be provided by the organizing committee. Other expenses incurred by the event organization shall be financed by the conveners and the group to which they belong, or by the organization or individual with the same vision.
